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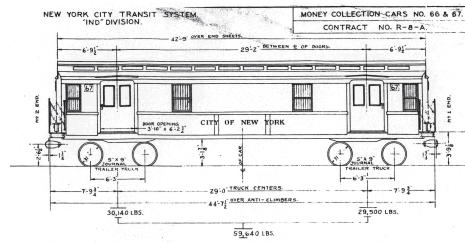

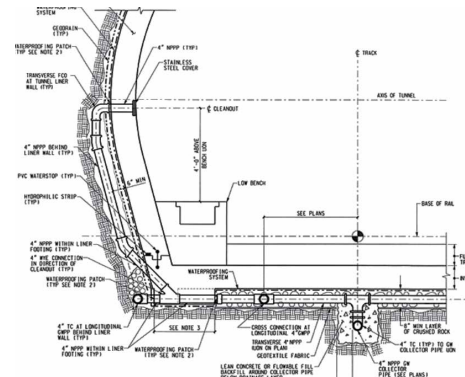

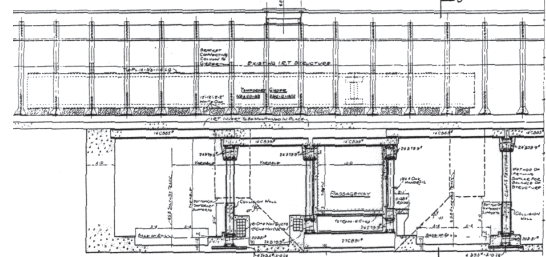


R8A (IND Revenue Collection Car 66-67, 1947

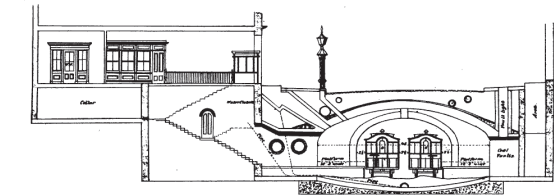


Crossing under IRT structure at Fulton Street

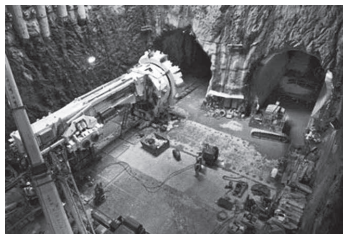
