

DELIVERABLES:

one 24"x24" drawing that curates your observations into a single drawing of observed phenomena, with a curated, or edited "site" which is a portion of your journey

one 11"x17" drawing that is a key/legend that documents and articulates your notation.

DUE:

First draft to be shared on Tuesday, Feb 5th.

DETAILS:

1. Invent a notation.

Based on the precedents and discussions shared in class, use your 5 drawings to formalize a system of notation.

2. Zoom in.

Choose a site and zoom in. We suggest that you draw a portion of your path at one of the following scales:

(A quick primer on scales:

1/2'' = 1'0'' means:

1/2" on the paper equals 1'-0" in real life. In other words, a 30ft wall will be drawn as 15 inches on the paper, since 30 * 1/2 = 15.)


3. Draw your site like it holds a novel.

What narratives and stories can be read within your site? What can you discover by looking with your notation?

4. Share your notation as a key.

Create a 'key' or legend that articulates and explains your notational system on a 11x17" paper.
